By making this pledge, an institution agrees to host a Syrian scholar-at-risk for a temporary academic position. This is not a legally binding commitment, but rather a declaration of intent that the institution will welcome Syrian scholars to allow them to continue their academic work in safety. Scholars at Risk (SAR) will vet scholar applications, work with the institution to find an appropriate academic match, smooth the scholar's transition to the host institution, and work with the scholar to identify next steps at the end of the position. SAR will also publicly recognize pledges through its website and other media.
